The Katori Nation has chosen to sell Bubbles Hand Car Wash certificates for this year's Golden Harvest annual fundraiser. Each certificate costs \$15 and can be exchanged for a Bubbles Hand Wash at any of their 5 Houston area locations. The Katori Nation will receive 50% of proceeds. 100% of Golden Harvest proceeds goes back into our community as part of teaching our children the importance of giving back and the "Friendly Service to Our Community" in our pledge.

Beneficiaries

- The Katori Nation's annual Golden Harvest raises funds to directly benefit Katy-area youth through the YMCA Partners Fund. These funds provide assistance for those in need of before and after-school childcare, summer day camps, youth sports, and teen leadership initiatives. Last year through collaboration with Katy ISD, Grand Vision, The ARC and the Katy YMCA, over 1000 adults and children, from the Katy area, received vision screenings, eyeglasses and access to YMCA programs and facilities
- Funds are also used for improvements at the YMCA's Camp Cinco. This facility is utilized by several area non-profit groups including The ARC of Katy, which uses Camp Cinco for activities and programs to fulfill their vision of providing opportunities for Katy youth with developmental disabilities to participate to the full extent of their ability in our community and to grow in mind, body, and spirit. The ARC program is community collaboration in which participants with varying degrees of autism and/or Downs Syndrome are enriched through YMCA sponsored programming.
- 100% of profit goes to causes – no administrative fees – no direct benefit to the Katori Nation

Expectations & Rewards

- Expectation is for each child in the Katori program to sell six (6) car wash certificates or raise an equivalent amount in cash donations (~\$45 profit equivalent).
- For every 20 car wash certificates a child sells, they will receive a \$25 Target Gift Card as a reward!
- All participating tribes (>50% of members participating) will earn valuable spirit points that will give them priority for Spring 2010 campout registration and an end of the year award party. Top revenue/member tribes will earn even more points.

Timeline and Logistics

- **November 2:** Car wash certificates will be distributed at Longhouse meeting. Chiefs will be issued **10 certificates** per child registered in their tribe.
- **December 7:** Chiefs will turn in the tribe log sheet, money and unsold car wash certificates at Longhouse meeting. Checks should be made out to **Katy YMCA**.

- Cash donations can be made by check made out to **Katy YMCA**. Cash donations are tax deductible. Please note "Golden Harvest donation" on the *Memo* line of the check.

We are financially responsible for all certificates issued. All unsold certificates must be returned at the December 7 Longhouse meeting or by separate arrangement with the TallyKeeper.
