2015 Aug 28 – 30	Camp Lutherhill La Grange, Texas Family Camp	<u>Cabin</u> camping not far from Katy. Screamer, climbing wall, pool, games, and a craft are activities as this camp. Family camp option, open to wives and siblings of all ages, or give Mom the weekend off and leave her at home.
Sept 18 – 20	Schlitterbahn – New Braunfels Jerry's Rentals camping	Enjoy the world famous water park late in the season. Camp next to the beautiful Guadalupe River. RV, Tent camping w/ electricity.
Oct 9 – 11	Beach Camp Galveston Island State Park	Tent camping on the Bay side of Galveston Island. Close to the beach but without the sand getting into every crevice. Swimming, fishing and side trips to the Galveston sites in town.
Nov 6 – 8	Longhorn Caverns Cave tour and camping KISD early dismissal Friday	Explore the famous cave in the scenic Texas Hill Country. Both mild (walking) and wild (crawling) tours will be offered. Camp nearby at beautiful Inks Lake SP. RV, Tent camping w/ electricity .
Dec 5	Service Project and Camp Cinco High Ropes	Spend a few hours helping the community (and earning valuable volunteer service hours) and then fly through the air on Camp Cinco's high rope elements.
2016 Jan 30 – 31	USS Lexington – Corpus Christi sleep on an aircraft carrier!	This 1943 aircraft carrier is now a naval and aviation museum. Spend the day touring the exhibits, watch an IMAX film, listen to ghost stories and then sleep in a sailors bunk.
Feb 26 – 28	Star Party / Brazos Bend Brazos Bend State Park	Friday night sleep indoors at the Observatory in Brazos Bend SP with private access to the telescopes and a night hike. Saturday Mars mission in the NASA Challenger center and then spend the afternoon exploring the park. Hike and Bike trails around the ponds let you safely observe birds and alligators in their natural habitat. Saturday night sleep in screened shelters.
April 1 – 3	Enchanted Rock #1 camp at Oxford Ranch	Hiking, rock climbing, rappelling and caving on the granite dome in the Central Texas hill country. Professional outfitters guide the climbing and rappelling, then explore the rock and cave on your own. One weekend is camping at the state park (tents only), one weekend camp at nearby Oxford Ranch. RV, Tent, or Trailer.
April 8 – 10	Enchanted Rock #2 camp at Oxford Ranch	
April 15 – 17	Enchanted Rock #3 camp at Oxford Ranch	
April 10	Pinewood Derby	Kids build & race a car with a little help from dad. Food and fun for the entire family!
April 29 – May 1	Cypress Valley Zip Lines zip line tour and swimming Krause Springs camping	The 90-minute Canopy Tour is a series of Zip lines and rope bridges in a valley of ancient cypress trees west of Austin. Afterwards zip into the lake for a swim or in the breathtaking limestone grotto of Krause Springs. RV, Tent, or Trailer.
May 20 – 22	San Marcos River canoeing, kayak, tubing and camping	Paddle the San Marcos river near Martindale, TX in a canoe or kayak with even a few friendly rapids. Afternoon tubing in San Marcos. Camp on the pecan-shaded banks of the river at Shady Grove campground. RV, Tent, or Trailer.
